The Academy is a 5 1/2 month long residential "military style" academy structured to promote an academic environment where students will earn a District of Columbia High School Diploma, develop leadership, job skills, and academic skills, while improving self-esteem, pride, and confidence. The New Beginnings Youth Development Center (NBYDC) is a secure and structured 60-bed male residential facility for DYRS committed youth. Its staff consists of dedicated professionals with extensive therapeutic experience and training in implementing evidence-based practices. DYRS focuses on preparing young people for a productive and successful re-entry into the community. Employ interventions that improve our youth's academic, behavioral, social-emotional, and vocational functioning. Engagement with these partner groups focused on our Raptor Research and Education program which is the hands-on study and conservation of raptors. They also engaged in watershed conservation and education programs through our Eco-Schools program through a grant with the US EPA. Whv: The DC high school drop-out rate is 32%. There is a 10-year difference in life expectancy and a 12.8% unemployment rate disparity between Ward 8 (16.8%) and Ward 2 (4.0%) as of February 2021 according to the Department of Employment Services. The International Journal of STEM Education reports that many minorities youth feel that they do not belong in STEM-based subjects and therefore do not pursue them. (Kricorian, et. al.) Nationally, the youth disconnection rate is 14.7% or 5.8 million young people. The most disconnected neighborhoods in DC are in Northeast and Southeast (Wards 7, 8)

Impact Being responsible for a wild raptor is a transformative experience that inspires a desire to complete high school, interest in STEM subjects, and a reconnection to self. We have seen the successful quest for a high school diploma blossom into a pursuit of higher education and careers in wildlife science and environmental restoration through the hands-on experiences of working in our raptor program. Our innovative programming has been recognized in scientific publications including "Leaders, Archetypes, and Totems: A Psychodynamic Theory of Sustainable Culture" by Dr. Janis L. Dickinson, Professor, Natural Resources, Professor of Citizen Science, Cornell Lab of Ornithology; and popular publications including, The Wonder of Birds by New York Times Science Writer, Jim Robbins. Earth Conservation Corps has engaged over 50,000 students in its school programs and 200 million around the world through our innovative raptor education program eaglecam.org. Program Focus 1 - Raptor Education & Conservation Humans have an innate fascination with raptors. We have found success through our formula of training adjudicated youth to care for our non-releasable education birds and present the public raptor education presentations mandated under FWS Permit #MB071444-0, Special Purpose - Possession for Education - Live Migratory Birds. In 2022 we again saw that the pairing of birds and youth offers mutual healing and often drives engagement in STEM can

A primary goal of both of our programs is to inspire our high school volunteers to become full time AmeriCorps leaders at our Anacostia River education centers. Over the course of 2022, Earth Conservation Corps continued engagement with the youth engaged with the Capital Guardian's high school dropout prevention program to execute the 2022 board plan to fund the focus of our service program on Raptor Education and Conservation. The board reaffirmed the commitment to provide secure funding for staff, facility construction and eagle care to support an application to the US Fish & Wildlife Service for an eagle exhibition permit. Commitment from the city for this application was reinforced by their renewal of our lease to the Wings Raptor education facility and the strong support to deploy our new raptor propagation permit inside the secure DYRS facility at New Beginnings. Earth Conservation Corps engaged cadets in a weekly elective experience that inspires a new generation of citizen scientists through the study of migratory birds and the challenges they face both in our urban environment and rapidly warming planet. We engaged two cohorts of volunteers in the 5 ½ month sessions (CGYCA class 57 and 58) that included citizen science, and workforce development. The cadets also focused on completing the first step in securing the eagle exhibition permit by constructing a 140ftx20ftx14ft eagle flight aviary. The workforce development component included goal setting, resume writing and interview skills. In FY22, 23 Cadets graduated from the Raptor Research and Conservation Elective program. They completed 1960 total service hours. We are also happy to report that in 2022, Earth Conservation Corps was granted a raptor propagation permit to begin a captive breeding program. Anacostia Raptor Watch is a citizen science program on our River Life Expedition boats to

One truly gets to see "A Tale of Two Cities". The lower Anacostia is very much an urban landscape. When you head upriver, everything changes, it gets quiet, the city disappears as one is enveloped by nature. You see an amazing hidden Anacostia that you can only witness on the water. Osprey, wood ducks, turtles, and kingfishers are your only noise. As learning continued online in 2021, Earth Conservation Corps had the advantage of a head start. In 2009, Anacostia Raptor Watch launched Washington's first live web eagle on the nest of Liberty and Justice, the now famous bald eagle pair is at the Metropolitan Police Academy. We managed the cameras in partnership with the Metropolitan Police Department and the National Geographic Society in what had become a global eagle education and citizens science project. As nature would have it, in 2020 the eagles abandoned their nest and moved a mile south to a tree on Oxon Cove. Just when the eagle cam would be most useful, it was streaming from an empty nest. We monitored the pair in their new nest site from afar but there was no consideration to adding a new camera until well after the nesting season. The osprey nest cam located on the Anacostia River has been the focus of a nest study under the guidance of Dr. Rob Bierregaard. Viewers from around the globe observe these birds of prey 24/7 through our web cameras. Raptor Education Programs EagleCorps members make an impact on the river through our raptor education programs. One of the most impactful ways we do this is by engaging our city's school children and the public. Our team of educators and raptor ambassadors will go into the public schools and teach the students the importance of conservation in their own communities. Children

These up close and exciting encounters ignite good conversations and inspire change in behavior towards our environment. In FY22, the Earth Conservation Corps raptor team engaged 1105 people in our Bird of Prey programs. Program Focus 2 - Anacostia River Restoration & Environmental Leadership "We work to have what we love." Earth Conservation EagleCorps members service focuses on restoring the Anacostia through direct action that exposes the entire community to the river and the reclamation fight. Full time EagleCorps members lead our environmental education programs giving students an opportunity to connect with the Anacostia River's past, present and future. EagleCorps members make a broad and hopeful long-term impact through education and make a direct impact on the river through restoration projects. In FY2022 Eagle Corps members engaged volunteers in service projects including trash removal from our trash traps and invasive plant removal in riparian areas along the Anacostia. In FY2022, our Eagle Corps members engaged approximately 505 volunteers in service projects. Band along trash trap/ data collection and trash mapping. Bandalong trash trap/data collection and trash mapping. - Since 1992, Earth Conservation Corps has worked to bring public attention to the trash and plastic pollution crippling the Anacostia River. In 1994 we created the first 'Trash Trap'' on the Anacostia River by securing a one-thousand-foot floating boom to trap the trash coming down the river and the trash coming out the First street combined sewer outfall. Showing the scale of the problem to elected representatives from DC and Maryland secured the installation of bandalong trash traps on all Anacostia River tributaries. FY2022 continued our trash trapping and analysis of a relentless stream of discarded plastic bottles, bags and waste. The traps we maintain are in; Watts Branch, James Creek,

After a rainfall, our team removes the trash manually from the traps and brings it to the Monique Johnson Center for sorting and categorizing. In 2022, staff and volunteers removed approximately 2,200 pounds of trash from the river. Through grants with the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, Earth Conservation Corps has restored 8500 square feet of wetland at Turtle Beach with native wetland plants that include, Arrow Arum, Wild Potato and Wild Rice. The restoration of the wetland at Turtle Beach continued in 2022 by leading volunteers in the removal of invasive species. Eco-schools - In June 2021, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency awarded a two-year Environmental Education Grant to train teachers in 5 areas schools how to better engage their students in nature. Eco-schools use "school-based action teams of students, administration, educators and community volunteers to drive environmental stewardship in schools". In FY2022, the grant continued and Earth Conservation Corps awarded an additional school with a subaward making it four schools to date with an environmental education grant. The schools to date are; Leckie Education Campus school in Ward 8, MacFarland Middle school in Ward 4, Excel Academy an all-girls school in Ward 8 and The Maya Angelou See Forever School inside the secure DYRS facility. Students are working on a school audit identifying a conservation based need at their school and will implement that project as a part of the grant. So far students have planted pollinator gardens on their school grounds. They have also been able to come to the Earth Conservation Corps for an on-the-water field experience and conduct some citizen science. In partnership with volunteers from the Office of Water at the US EPA, the students had the opportunity to monitor water quality of the Anacostia River testing turbidity, oxygen and PH levels of our water. Green Zone Environmental Program (GZEP) - Earth Conservation Corps continued its partnership with the District Department of the Environment's (DOEE) summer workforce development program - Green Zone Environmental Program (GZEP). In FY22 Our team ran a hybrid six-week program for 60 youth who participated in an environmental filmmaking experience. The youth focused on Climate Change and worked on making a 5-minute film with the Smart Surfaces Coalition. They learned about the impact that heat has on an urban landscape and ways to mitigate that through Green Infrastructure. The youth were able to film and interview Senator Sheldon Whitehouse on the issue. The youth learned about climate change, film production, interview skills and were able to help create a 5-minute film on the issue. Friday Night Fish Lab - During the summer months, families can come down to the Monique Johnson Anacostia River Center and participate in our free fishing clinics on Friday nights. Squeals of delight can be heard from the street as kids reel in their first wriggling catfish and families get to experience the outdoors together. Inspired by Dr. Sylvia Earle, our Friday Night Fishing program is now Friday Night Fish Lab, a STEM wildlife research program in partnership with USGS, Ketrick Fishing Community and Capital Guardian Youth ChalleNGe Academy. This citizen science program includes peer-quided data collection, seminars on data analysis and educational dissection demonstrations. Our Corps members collect the data (alongside USGS) through weight, size (TL & SL), and collection of the otoliths (ear bones) for age approximation. In 2022, approximately 550 people engaged in Friday Night Fishing and Fish Lab. Workforce Development In addition to direct service, our EagleCorps members participate in green infrastructure training that can prepare them for meaningful careers in a growing industry and the soft
